We are delighted to announce the 14th annual CRIEVAT Student Symposium on the theme of **(Re)Build yourself: when change invites itself in school and professional paths**. Open to the French- and English-speaking university community, it will focus on:

- **EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCES, TRANSITIONS AND LIFELONG GUIDANCE**
 - Professional choices, school paths and transitions / Educational experiences / Work experience, orientation and lifelong learning / etc.
- **WORK RELATIONSHIP AND DIVERSITY OF CAREER PATHS**
 - Psychosocial development / Psychological health / Sustainable and satisfactory maintenance in employment / Work activity and psychosocial work environment / etc.
- **DEVELOPMENT OF INDIVIDUAL, COLLECTIVE AND INSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT PRACTICES**
 - Sociocultural and professional diversity / Intervention approaches / Development and implementation of intervention / Analysis and transformation of practices / etc.
- **DEVELOPMENT OF PROFESSIONS, ORGANIZATIONS AND POLICIES FROM A SOCIAL JUSTICE PERSPECTIVE**
 - Collective dynamics and power relations / Social justice and reduction of inequalities / Sociocultural and technological changes / Exclusion and inclusion / etc.

The main objective of this event is to create a relaxed setting that will serve as an interdisciplinary exchange space where masters and doctoral students from the fields of education, social sciences and the humanities (sociology, guidance, counselling, psychology, administration, economy, industrial relations, etc.) can present their research project, no matter the stage they are at (literature review, issue, methodology, research results). A jury will also award prizes for the best presentations. Presentations may take one of two forms:

Oral (in French or English):

20 minutes will be allowed for each presentation, plus a question and answer period with the audience.

Poster (in French or English):

Poster presentations will be scheduled throughout the symposium.

Proposals will be reviewed by a scientific committee consisting of undergraduate and graduate students. Replies to your proposals will be sent by mid December 2021.

Please note that registration will be **free** for presenters. Also, the formula chosen for this year's symposium is **hybrid**: there will be in person and videoconference presentations.
